Wilderness First Aid Basics was developed by the American Red Cross to meet the first aid training needs for anyone who spends time in remote areas where emergency care will be delayed in an emergency. This class covers assessment and urgent first aid techniques, but not in-depth CPR. Basic first aid skills are covered, making this course appropriate for anyone regardless of experience level.

No prerequisites are required. A three year Wilderness and First Aid Basic certification is issued upon completion. A minimum age of 15 is recommended for participants due to the serious nature of the course and scenarios. Course Content
